A technical talk on "Great Challenges and Opportunities in Geophysics: The state of our technology, our business and the SEG" by Dr. Craig J Beasley, President SEG, USA was organized on 13<sup>th</sup> of January 2005 at Hotel Tunga International, Andheri(E), Mumbai.

About 100 Geoscientists and Engineers from ONGC, Reliance Petroleum, British Gas, Schlumberger attended the talk.

Shri M.B. Singh GGM(Geophy) & President SPG, Mumbai Chapter thanked Dr. Beasley for coming to Mumbai despite his very busy schedule to deliver the talk in his welcome address.

In his talk Dr. Beasley highlighted the Challenges faced by Geophysical technologies in

increasing production and lowering risk and cost. It was emphasized that Geophysicists continue to respond with better solutions to E&P needs by providing better, higher-resolution data, more accurate imaging and sophisticated integration of seismic data with other Geoscientific and Reservoir Engineering information. Yet, we face significant challenges in the coming years. During the course of the talk, Dr. Beasley reviewed economic, technical and professional trends that affect today's Geophysicist and discussed the measures the SEG is taking to respond to these issues. Dr. Beasley also presented some of the recent advances like Q-marine, steerable streamers etc. and hoped that future of Geophysics will be even brighter.
