

# Glimpses of 4<sup>th</sup> Conference & Exposition on Petroleum Geophysics, Society of Petroleum Geophysicists, India (Mumbai - 2002) Jan 7-9, 2002



The Society of Petroleum Geophysicists (SPG), India held its 4th Conference & Exposition on Petroleum Geophysics 'Mumbai 2002' during January 7-9, 2002 at Mumbai.
