CALL FOR PAPERS

Technical Programme Committee invites technical papers in the form of Expanded Abstracts, on wide range of topics indicated on submission form overleaf. Authors are requested to indicate the most suitable topic under which their expanded abstract should be considered by the committee. The technical Program Committee will consider expanded abstracts received by 31st October, 2005.

The Technical Programme will consist of both oral and poster sessions. Authors should indicate their preference for presenting their paper either as an oral or poster presentation. Preference of author for a particular style of presentation shall be borne in mind at the time of final program composition. However, the decision of Technical Program Committee shall be final in this regard.

Oral presentation of technical papers will be held simultaneously in separate sessions to accommodate wide ranging topics of interest. Audio-visual aids would include one 35-mm slide projectors, and projection for PC based presentations (single screen projection). The authors are requested to indicate the type of projection required when they submit their expanded abstracts for the conference.

Poster sessions will be held at least on two days during the conference. A single display board (138 cm x 98 cm) will be provided for each poster. The minimum letter size in the text should be of 7 mm height. Use of multicolour is recommended.

Instructions on Expanded Abstracts

- The expanded abstract should be abbreviated, informative, accurate representation of the paper and not a mere recital of the subjects to be covered.
- Organization of the expanded abstract should broadly follow this scheme :

1. Summary
2. Introduction
3. Theory and/or method (or author may choose some other title)
4. Examples (optional)
5. Conclusions
6. Acknowledgements (optional)
7. References

- Length of an expanded abstract should not exceed six A4 sized page (8.5 x 11 inches). Preferred font size is 9 point, normal weight, Times New Roman.
- Abstract must be written in English
- Figures and tables should be included within the text copy at the place desired by the authors. No re-setting of the material is envisaged.
- Author should submit two hard copies of the expanded abstracts along with a soft copy (less than 4 MB) containing the expanded abstract. Expanded abstract can also be submitted on-line at SPG website. Abstracts submitted through fax will not be considered.
- Author should return the expanded abstract, along with the form given overleaf, to Conference Secretariat. Copy of the form may also be used, if required.

The papers accepted for presentation will be published in the form of proceedings of the conference. Only properly written expanded abstracts that are in line with the instructions given above will be considered. The acceptance of paper by the Technical Program Committee will, therefore, be entirely based on expanded abstracts.

How to submit a manuscript

- Two copies of the full manuscripts (including abstract) are required on 8.5 x 11 inch paper (A4 size) along with a CD-ROM containing the paper.
- Manuscripts should be typed on one side of the paper only, double spaced with margins. Authors should keep the paper to the maximum length of 20 (twenty) pages including figures and tables.
- Figures and tables should not be included within the text copy but should follow the manuscript, with each original figure and / or tables in separate sheet along with captions.
- All the figures preferably may be given in digital form (Tiff or JPG format) having at least 300 dpi resolution to maintain the image quality
- Manuscripts should clearly indicate the optimum positions of figures and tables, though production reasons may necessitate some changes.
- References should be listed alphabetically and must appear at the end of main body of the text, but ahead of appendices, if any.
- Responsibility for obtaining necessary permission to publish the paper and use figures and tables previously published in other books or journals rests with the Authors.
- Passport size photographs of all authors with brief bio-data should accompany the manuscript.

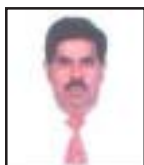
